#### **REPORT FROM COUNCIL PRESIDENT, JOE MARTIN**

Council met two times in April. A special meeting was held on April 4<sup>th</sup>. A Gifting Policy was added to our policies and procedures. Any undedicated gifts will be distributed to the church as follows: 70 percent will be distributed to the general fund, 20 percent will be invested in the endowment fund and 10 percent will be distributed to the capital improvement fund.

Council met on April 18<sup>th</sup> and had a tele-visit with our new Vice Pastor Wendolyn Trozzo. All in attendance agreed it was a great meeting and we all look forward to our time together. Pastor Trozzo has cleared her schedule to be with us through at least the end of July.

Council discussed the new Grace Investment Fund Committee and this committee has been added to our constitution. To date we have several members volunteering to join the committee and would like more. This committee will study our present fund and investigate alternatives to be presented to council and our support team. This new committee will be meeting for their first time in May.

#### **GIVING WITH GRACE**
